- * Free tafe - SAS may continue to enrol eligible students until 31 December 2020 who are currently eligible under Free tafe for Year 12 graduates. Those students already enrolled in Free tafe prior to 1 January 2021 may teach out in their existing qualification.
- * Free TAFE for under 25s - from 1 January 2021, Free TAFE for under 25s will be available for delivery by TAFE Queensland and CQUniversity only to eligible students. - * Priority Skill Sets are identified with the word "skill set" at the end of the training product name and applies to the Higher Level Skills program only.
