Review the eligibility and selection criteria to consider if these categories are right for you:

- Outstanding Achievement in the VET and Skills Sector Award
- Australian Apprenticeships Employer Award
- School Pathways to VET Award
- Excellence in Language, Literacy and Numeracy Practice Award
- Innovation in VET Award

Nominations for these awards will close on 31 May 2023. This year's Australian Training Awards gala event will be held in Hobart in November and Queensland will have a strong team representing us.
