



## Government funded VET outcomes

### Region

- A total of 87,260 qualifications were completed in the publicly funded vocational education and training (VET) system during 2022-23.
- Qualification completions in Far North Queensland had the highest absolute increase, up 23.6 per cent (or 1,201) between 2018-19 and 2022-23.
- In 2022-23, more than 70 per cent of qualification completions were awarded in South East (25.7 per cent), Metropolitan (25.6 per cent) and North Coast (21.1 per cent).
