

## Government funded VET outcomes

### Region

- A total of 87,292 qualifications were completed in the publicly funded vocational education and training (VET) system during 2019-20.
- In 2019-20, more than half of all qualification completions pertained to students who resided in either the Metropolitan Region (25.6 per cent), or the South East Region (26.9 per cent). Additionally the North Coast Region has over a fifth (21.9 per cent) of all qualification completions.
