



## Government funded VET outcomes

### Provider type

- A total of 87,260 qualifications were completed in the government funded vocational education and training (VET) system during 2022-23.
- In 2022-23, almost two thirds (67.8 per cent) of all government funded qualification completions were registered with a non-government provider.

All Queensland TAFE institutes, Central Queensland University, University of Queensland Skills, Queensland Agricultural College and Queensland College of Wine Tourism are classified as 'TAFE and other government providers'. All other providers are classified as 'Non-Government Providers'. Schools are excluded from government-funded reporting.
