



## **Government funded VET outcomes**

## **Australian Qualifications Framework**

- A total of 87,260 qualifications were completed in the government funded vocational education and training (VET) system during 2022-23.
- Qualification completions increased between 2018-19 and 2022-23 in Certifcate I and II by 3,060 (or 9.7 per cent) and Diploma and above by 210 (or 2.6 per cent).
- In 2022-23, 42.7 per cent of all completions were in Certificate III programs, followed by 39.7 per cent in Certificate I and II programs.
