

Government funded VET participation

Provider type

- A total of 212,032 Queensland students participated in government funded vocational education and training (VET) during 2019-20.
- Of all government funded students in Queensland in 2019-20, 34.3 per cent studied at a government provider and 67.9 per cent studied at a non-government provider.

Notes:

- a. Data is for government funded VET students only, which includes all students funded by government regardless of their provider type.
- b. TAFE, universities and agricultural colleges are counted as 'government providers'. All other provider types are counted under 'non-government providers'.
- c. A student is only counted if the student had at least one competency outcome (successful or otherwise) in the reporting period.
- d. Summing the students for each provider type may not equal the total. This is because individual students may study at government and non-government providers.
