 - These day-long events take students around a range of local agricultural industries for a snapshot of the roles within the company and career pathways.

 - A Rural Champion will come to your classroom and give a presentation to your students on agricultural industries, following a paddock to plate process.
 - Can be tailored to suit particular area of study and to primary and secondary students.

 - Held at major agricultural events, Career Conversations is an informal BBQ and conversation about career pathways with those already involved in the industry.
